

A 30 minute program for young skaters aged 3 to 7. No previous skating experience is required. We provide a small group environment where children are encouraged to stand on their own and balance and control at their own pace. Skaters are assessed at their first class and grouped by ability. Skaters that are able to stand and move on their own begin working on the CanSkate badges.

Equipment: All participants must wear a CSA certified helmet with a cage and gloves, as well as snow pants/waterproof pants.

Note: This is an introduction to hockey. Hockey gear is optional. If your child can not skate by themselves please sign-up for our beginner learn to skate program first. OR do a 1/2 hour of Learn to Skate and 1/2 hour of Learn to play back. Kids must wear ice skates, hockey helmets with full-face cages, and hockey gloves or thick winter gloves to participate or full equipment once they can skate properly.
